### NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- The building will be open for setup on Saturday and Sunday mornings beginning at 8:00 a.m. The building must be vacated one hour after the end of judging on Sunday.
- Judging will be indoors. Expanded grooming area will be available indoors.
- No chalking in building.
- Floor covering is required under grooming and crate set-ups. A limited number of tarps will be available for purchase for a nominal fee at the show site. Owners and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around crating area.
- Crates and tables may be left overnight on Saturday. The building will be LOCKED. NO DOGS MAY BE LEFT OVERNIGHT.
- Dogs may arrive any time before judging of the class begins. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when its class is called.
- All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. Please keep dogs on leash at all times.
- All prizes (including cash) will be awarded in the ring to the person exhibiting the dog who shall be considered the owner or agent when judging of that class is over. All claims for prizes must be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging and the Show Secretary advised at once of any discrepancy. The Show Secretary and show-giving club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over. All trophies must be picked up the day of the show. None will be mailed. The club reserves the right to substitute any prize that may become unavailable with a prize of equal or greater value.
- Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Licensed Events.
- All persons are responsible for picking up after their dogs. Anyone not picking up after their dog will be asked to leave the show grounds. There will be no smoking on the show grounds. Please dispose of all trash in the proper manner. Please help keep our show grounds clean!!
- The Show-giving Club, Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or any of their dogs, or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.
- Light refreshments will be available on site on Saturday and Sunday.
- Please bring your own chairs

**IMPORTANT!** Transfers of dogs from regular classes to Best of Breed/Variety Competition and transfers of dogs determined to be ineligible for the class in which it has been entered to an Open class (Ch. 11, Sec. 6, AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows) must be made to the Show Secretary at least 1/2 hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at this show.

## COVID PROTOCOL
