FEES

\$30 for each entry of a dog in a regular class; \$22 for puppy (under 12 months) and non-regular classes. Each entry fee, each day includes a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee. Each first entry fee each day also includes a 50 cent AKC Recording Fee. (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions.)

Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

MAKE ALL CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO: **THE SHETLAND SHEEPDOG CLUB OF GREATER BALTIMORE** (or **SSCGB**). ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made. All fees collected by the show-giving club are paid to the American Kennel Club. (*American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2.*)

COVID INFORMATION

The SSCGB will follow local jurisdiction COVID protocol, which as of mid-January all of the COVID-19 mitigation orders are lifted in Pennsylvania, but individual businesses can establish their own guidelines.

In an effort to make the event as safe as possible exhibitors will be required to wear properly worn masks (covering both nose and mouth) while inside the building (except when eating or drinking), including in the ring. Bandanas and face shields worn without a mask are not acceptable.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- ☛ Judging will be indoors.
- ☛ The building will not be available for setup until Saturday morning. Setup times will be posted to the judging schedule.
- ☛ Dogs may not be left overnight.
- ☛ All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.
- ☛ Extended grooming area will be available indoors. Chalking in designated area only.
- ☛ Floor covering is required under grooming and crate set-ups. A limited number of tarps will be available for purchase for a nominal fee at the show site.
- ☛ All prizes will be awarded in the ring to the person exhibiting the dog who shall be considered the owner or agent when judging of that class is over. All claims for prizes must be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging and the Show Secretary advised at once of any discrepancy. The Show Secretary and show-giving club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over. All trophies must be picked up the day of the show. None will be mailed. The club reserves the right to substitute any prize that may become unavailable with a prize of equal or greater value.
- ☛ There will be no smoking on the show grounds. Please dispose of all trash in the proper manner.
- ☛ Please help us keep our show grounds clean!!!
- ☛ Food will be available.
- ☛ Bring your own chairs.
- ☛ Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
