CHECK-IN

Gate sheets will be posted ringside. Any changes in running order must be done by the Gate Steward for each class.

CRATING AND SETUP

The site will be open at 7:00 AM on Saturday and Sunday. The building will NOT be open for crating on Friday evening. There will be plenty of space available for indoor crating. **Please bring a waterproof tarp to place underneath your dog's crate, chair and other equipment you may bring to the trials.** No food or drinks (other than water) are permitted on the turf field. If there is an accident, there is a \$5.00 charge to offset the cost of cleaning the turf. In addition, dog treats, if used, must be of a solid, non-crumbling, non-staining nature.

COVID INFORMATION

According to current CDC guidance, masks should be worn indoors by all people, regardless of vaccination status, in areas of “substantial” or “high” community transmission. As a result, the SSCGB recommends that all competitors wear a mask if Baltimore County is in the substantial/high zone at the time of the trial.

PARKING

There is plenty of parking available on-site. Limited daytime RV parking is also available (no electric or hookup). Contact Cindy Deubler for additional information (rosiepup@verizon.net).

FOOD

Food will **not** be available on-site; however, there are several eating establishments nearby.

MEASURING

Our judge is not a VMO but dogs who do not have a Permanent Height Card or temporary jump height form (yellow) will still have to be measured prior to running.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

A worker board will be available at the trial to sign up for your favorite job run by our wonderful worker coordinator Barb Miller! If, however, you can work the first class either day, please contact Barb Miller (barbscottmiller@embarqmail.com) to give her a heads up. And thank you in advance for volunteering! A successful trial is dependent upon its volunteers. As an extra incentive, coupons will be given to each worker to offset costs of future entries. Each day, a worker raffle will be held for free future entries and other prizes.

DOG POTTY AREA

Dogs shall be exercised in designated sections of the grassy areas near the entrance to the parking lot. Please do not allow your dogs to relieve themselves against the building structure or the bushes in front of the building entrance.

Signs will be posted in the facility on the doors leading out of the building and on the doors leading into/out of the sports field identifying the designated potty area on the opposite side of the parking lot.

MOVE-UP INFORMATION

The deadline for move-ups is Monday, September 20 at 6:00 p.m. Please email move-up requests to the Trial Secretary (Debbie Kaminski – dekamin@aol.com). Day-to-day move-ups will be allowed between the trials and will be taken up to one-half hour after the conclusion of the last class on Saturday. These move-ups must be submitted in writing at the trial site to the Trial Secretary. Move-up forms will be available on-site.

RUN FOR GLORY!! and VETERANS PARADE – SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 25

Run for Glory – Relive the thrill of running your retired agility dog in the ring! Jump height of your choice (or NO height!). Jumps and tunnels only. You may block the tunnels. This is a celebration with our teammates who still have the desire, but no longer get the chance to see the agility ring. No age limit but restricted to **unentered dogs** only. Sign-up sheets will be available at the check-in table on the morning of the event.

Veterans Parade – for entered Shelties that are 10 years of age or older and **entered** in the trial. Each participant will receive a commemorative rosette. A rosette will also be awarded each day to the Oldest Qualifying Dog. There is no entry fee.

These events will take place after T2B and before Novice JWW

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

From 95 North: Take Exit 50A-50B onto Caton Ave toward South Washington. Keep right onto Caton Ave S towards Washington Blvd. Turn right onto Joh Ave. Turn left onto Benson Ave. Turn left onto Knecht Ave. Turn left onto Azar Ct - #9 is on the right.

From Interstate 695/Baltimore Beltway traveling towards Essex: Take Exit 11A-11B for Interstate 95 South towards Washington. Keep right and follow signs for Sulphur Spring Rd. Turn right onto Sulphur Spring Rd. (signs say Arbutus/Violetville). Turn right onto Benson Ave. Turn right onto Knecht Ave. Turn left onto Azar Ct. - #9 is on the right.

From Interstate 695/Baltimore Beltway traveling towards Towson: Take Exit 10 for US-1 ALT/Washington Blvd. in Halethorpe. Turn left onto Rt. 1. Turn right onto Sulphur Spring Rd. Turn right onto Benson Ave. Turn right onto Knecht Ave. Turn left onto Azar Ct. - #9 is on the right.
